CFO Maura Velasco-Ventura began her career with the City of Long Beach in 2009 as an Administrative Analyst assigned to the Police Department's Patrol Bureau. In November 2013, as an Administrative Analyst II, she was assigned to the City's Budget Management Bureau. There she served as the budget analyst for the Airport, City Auditor, Human Resources, and Development Services Departments.

On September 25, 2014, she was promoted as Administrator of the Police Department's Records and Technology Division. Administrator Velasco-Ventura was responsible for managing a \$19 million operations budget, overseeing 83 employees, and managing the data, statistical reporting, technology projects and fleet force for the Police Department. In 2015, she was promoted to Chief Financial Officer.

CFO Velasco-Ventura earned a Master of Public Administration from the University of Southern California, and two Bachelor of Arts Degrees in Political Science and History from the University of California, Irvine.
