Commander Wally Hebeish currently serves as the Chief of Staff for Chief of Police Robert Luna. He was promoted in 2015 and was assigned to the Internal Affairs Division. He began his career in law enforcement in 1994 with the Orange County Sheriff's Department. In 1995, he transferred to the Long Beach Police Department.
