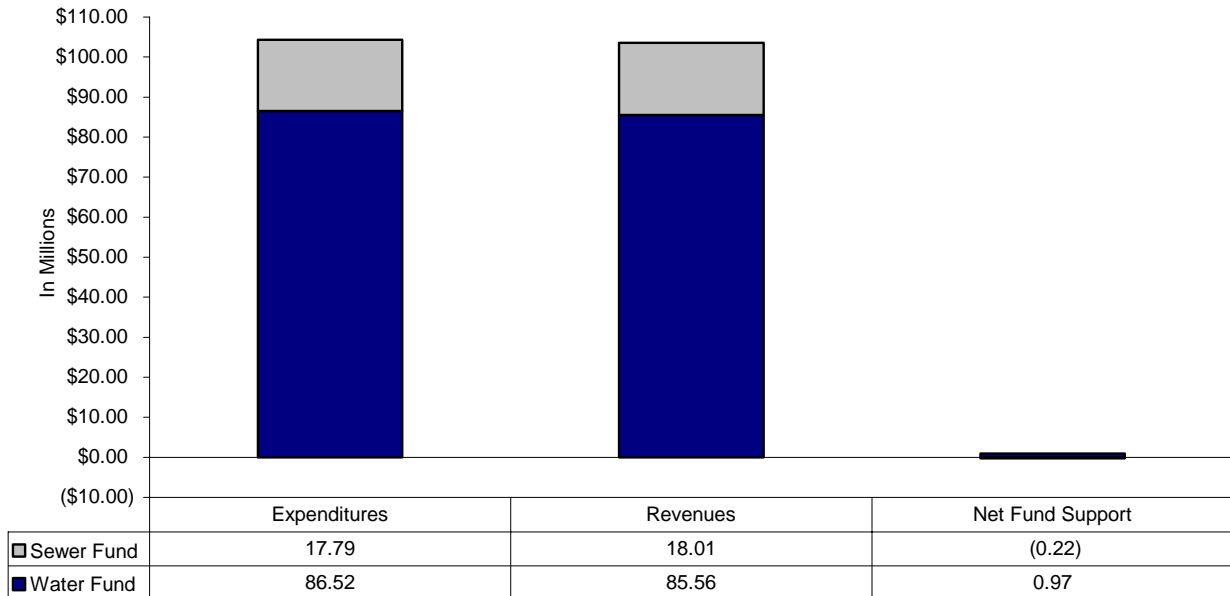


WATER
