**PERIOD OF PRIMARY AND REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS FOR THE CITY OF LONG**  
**BEACH BALLOT MEASURE APPEARING ON THE**  
**NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION BALLOT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a consolidated General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Long Beach on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 for the purposes of placing before the voters of the City of Long Beach one local ballot measure.

"LONG BEACH COMMUNITY SERVICES GENERAL PURPOSE OIL PRODUCTION TAX INCREASE MEASURE. To provide funding for community healthcare services; air/water quality and climate change programs; increase childhood education/ youth programs; expand job training opportunities; and maintain other general fund programs, shall a measure be adopted increasing Long Beach's general oil production tax from 15¢ to maximum 30¢ per barrel, subject to annual adjustments, generating approximately \$1,600,000 annually, until ended by voters, requiring audits/ local control of funds?"

For this election, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk will conduct the election and mail Official Sample Ballots to all Long Beach voters. The Official Sample Ballot includes the measure's ballot title, the City Attorney's impartial analysis, proposed measure text, direct arguments for and against, and rebuttal arguments.

The public examination periods for arguments and rebuttal are August 15, 2020 to August 24, 2020 and August 25, 2020 to September 3, 2020, respectively.

All Long Beach voters will receive a Vote by Mail ballot for the November 3, 2020 election to ensure voters have a safe and accessible voting option during the COVID-19 pandemic. All voters should check their voter registration information to ensure their mailing address and voter information is up-to-date. Voters will be encouraged to return their voted ballot by mail (no postage required) or at one of 16 Vote by Mail Drop Box locations in Long Beach. Additionally, safe in-person Vote Centers will be available for early voting and on Election Day.
