City of Long Beach Polystyrene Food Packaging Ordinance

Administrative Rules and Regulations

Pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code section 8.63.040, the undersigned Director of the Department of Public Works hereby adopts these rules and regulations concerning Long Beach Municipal Code section 8.63.010 et seq, the City of Long Beach Polystyrene Food Packaging Ordinance (the "Ordinance"), for the purpose of clarifying the administrative requirements of the Ordinance.

8.63.030 Prohibition against distribution or sale of polystyrene food service ware.

Section F

1. All Food Providers shall certify compliance with this Chapter as part of the Environmental Health inspection process. No person, vendor, business or event promoter may sell, rent or otherwise provide any polystyrene beads used as filler for toys and beanbags and in crafts and Polystyrene Coolers or ice chests, where such foam is not wholly encapsulated or encased with a more durable material.

This regulation was posted soliciting comments not less than 21 days prior to adoption at City Hall public counters and on Public Works/Environmental Service Bureau's website, and were posted an additional ten days thereafter prior to becoming final.
