Reported March 2020 Regarding the December 2019 Meeting

All peace officer personnel records, including information relating to specific deliberations of the Citizen Police Complaint Commission and findings by the City Manager, shall be kept confidential to the extent required by law. In order to comply with this requirement, certain information may have been withheld in this report.

After its **December 12, 2019** meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the **December 12, 2019** meeting are:

COMMISSION

- Sustained – 3 allegations
- Not Sustained – 35 allegations
- Exonerated - 2 allegations
- Unfounded – 25 allegations
- Re-Investigate – 1 allegation

CITY MANAGER

- Sustained – 1 allegation
- Not Sustained – 34 allegations
- Exonerated – 3 allegations
- Unfounded – 28 allegations
- Re-Investigate – 0 allegations

The Commission submitted a request for the Long Beach Police Department (LBPD) to create a policy on putting cell phones into evidence.
