Subject: Notice of Grant Application

This letter serves as notification only in order to comply with federal filing requirements for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance (JAG) Program administered by the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). If awarded the grant, a formal request will be presented to the City Council to accept the grant and to make any applicable budget adjustments.

- This is the eleventh year the JAG grant has replaced the Federal Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) program that the City participated in for ten years prior to the introduction of JAG.
- The total grant amount is \$194,836 and will be used for a portion of the Los Angeles County Probation Officer (est. \$35,836 funded from JAG 15) and the continuation of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department DNA Senior Criminalist (est. \$159,000).
- The Police Department will file a grant application on behalf of the City of Long Beach. There is no City match requirement. The application deadline is June 24, 2015.
- This memorandum meets the requirement stated in the grant solicitation package to make the JAG application available for review by the governing body before the application is submitted to BJA.
