Subject: DMV Office Closure for Remodeling

The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) has announced that the DMV field office located at 3700 E. Willow Street in Long Beach will be temporarily closed for renovations beginning Friday, October 30, 2015 at 12:00 pm, and is scheduled to re-open to the public on Wednesday, February 17, 2016, at 9:00 am.

During this period, the DMV is encouraging customers to access their services by mail, online at www.dmv.ca.gov, or by making an appointment to visit another nearby field office in Bellflower, Compton, Torrance, San Pedro or Westminster, where Long Beach DMV staff will be temporarily deployed to help with increased work flow. Appointments can also be made by calling 800.777.0133.

To help mitigate impacts, the City will use its Social Media platforms to inform the community about the temporary closure, and how to access DMV services.
