Subject: **Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee Update**

On August 16, 2016, staff will bring an item to the City Council requesting its approval to update the City's approved crossing guard locations as recommended by the Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC). The PSAC is recommending adding three new locations and eliminating seven locations that no longer meet established criteria.

Background

To ensure that crossing guards are appropriately deployed, in 1978 Long Beach voters approved through a ballot initiative the establishment of the Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC). The Committee's primary purpose is to advise the City Council on the assignments of crossing guard locations throughout the City. Intersections are evaluated based on Long Beach Municipal Code Ordinance 10.68.010, which details the criteria necessary for approving a crossing guard, such as number of children crossing per hour or amount of cars passing through the intersection (see additional information provided in memorandum dated December 11, 2015).

After review of the stated criteria staff provided a report to PSAC, who took the following actions:

Based on the evaluation results, PSAC voted to approve adding crossing guards at the following intersections:

The study results indicated that the following intersections no longer met the criteria for a crossing guard assignment. PSAC voted to remove these locations from the current list of approved crossing guard designated locations:



Subject: Update on the Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee and School Crossing Guard Program

The City Council, through an agenda item initiated by Councilmember Austin, requested the City Manager to provide: the status of the Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee; an overview of the City's school crossing guard program; and the City's overall efforts to ensure traffic safety in school zones. This memorandum responds to that request.

Background

The need for school crossing guards evolves over time as a consequence of neighborhood changes, new school construction, population redistribution, school schedule changes, and traffic control signalization upgrades. To ensure that crossing guards are appropriately deployed, in 1978, Long Beach voters, through a City ballot initiative, established the Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC) to advise the City Council on the assignment of crossing guards locations throughout the City.

For many years, the PSAC operated as intended; however, over time, it became inactive for the following reasons:

- Turnover in the volunteers serving as Committee members;
- A requirement that Committee members undergo Live Scan fingerprinting;
- A requirement that Committee members file a Form 700; and
- An inability to achieve a quorum.

In 2013, the City Manager's Office, along with the Public Works Department and Long Beach Police Department (LBPD), worked closely with Council Offices, the Parent Teacher Association, and the Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD) to re-activate the PSAC. After much effort, a sufficient number of Committee members was secured, and the PSAC met on May 7, 2015 - the first time since 2008. This first meeting served as an orientation for the new Committee members.

The PSAC convened again on August 13, 2015. The main order of business was to evaluate a request from the LBPD related to the status of six intersections that, at an earlier point in time, were staffed with crossing guards. Over time, due to neighborhood changes, new school construction, population redistribution, school schedule changes and traffic control signalization upgrades, the crossing guards, in coordination with LBUSD, were removed. The PSAC's evaluation concluded that

these six intersections, listed in the table below, no longer meet the criteria for crossing guard assignment.

School Crossing Guard Program

The School Crossing Guard Program has 82 positions to support 65 locations, of which 17 of the locations are assigned two crossing guards; however, due to high turnover, these 17 locations are currently staffed with one guard. The Program currently has 42 crossing guards for deployment to cover all locations. An additional 20 applicants are currently undergoing background checks and Live Scan. Assuming all applicants are cleared for hire, this will bring the total complement of crossing guards to 62 for deployment.

For FY 16, the School Crossing Guard Program has a budget of \$972,050 with 25.23 approved full-time equivalent positions.

Safe Routes to School Program

To encourage safety, Public Works collaborated with LBUSD to create its Safe Routes to School Program. This website, located at <http://www.longbeach.gov/pw/resources/general/school-walking-route/>, provides maps of safe walking routes for schools located within the District. These maps encourage an interactive conversation between a parent or guardian and their child by providing a map that identifies a school route, traffic signal locations, and crossing guard locations. The map also provides instructions to parents and guardians to identify the preferred walking route collaboratively with their child, and to walk the route in advance. The website provides additional safety tips and advice for parents, guardians, and children. Additionally, to facilitate traffic safety in school zones, signs demarcating a school zone are posted, cautioning motorists to heed a 25-mile per hour speed limit when children are present.

Next Steps

The Pedestrian Safety Advisory Committee continues to meet and periodic updates will be provided to the City Council, including a deployment plan for the 2016-2017 School Year.
