**Subject:** Long Beach Airport – JetBlue Inaugural Flight to Reno

In March 2016, JetBlue Airways (JetBlue) announced that they would begin providing service from Reno to Long Beach, its gateway to Southern California, giving travelers easy access to the Los Angeles Basin. As is customary to commemorate the inaugural flight of a new carrier or a new destination, Long Beach Airport (Airport) and JetBlue will be hosting an event to celebrate the inaugural flight to Reno.

The event will take place in the Airport concourse on Monday, August 15, 2016. There will be light refreshments served at 8:45 a.m., followed by a program at 9:15 a.m., featuring remarks from Vice Mayor Rex Richardson, Councilwoman Stacy Mungo, Juan López-Rios, Interim Airport Director, and Lou Anthony, JetBlue's Station Manager. Due to Transportation Security Administration requirements, attendees must confirm their attendance no later than Friday, August 8, 2016, and will be asked to provide their full name, birthdate, and, on the day of the event, present a government-issued form of photo identification.
