Mayor Robert Garcia, Councilmember Al Austin, and the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine invite you and your staff to attend the grand opening ceremony of C. David Molina Park, at 4951 Oregon Avenue, on Tuesday, August 28, 2018, at 9:30 a.m.

The park sits on approximately 3.3 acres of land, and includes a sports field, playground, restroom facility, walking path, parking, and landscaping. The sports field was created with synthetic turf, energy-efficient field lights, and fencing, and will provide additional hours of play for Long Beach sports organizations. The decomposed granite walking path and the fitness stations provide an opportunity for healthy outdoor exercise. The premier playground features dynamic, universally-accessible play structures, as well as a climbing structure, safety surfacing, and colorful shade structures. Park benches, bike racks, picnic tables, landscaping, and parking complement the park use. This new park is user-friendly for a variety of age groups and activity levels and will be a valuable asset to the community.

The park was a requirement of a development agreement with the developer who built the homes in the Riverdale residential tract.
