Subject: **"Beach Streets Pacific Avenue" Open Street Event**

The next Open Street event, "Beach Streets Pacific Avenue," will take place on Saturday, April 27 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (flyer attached). The route features Pacific Avenue and Willow Street by temporarily closing the streets to vehicular traffic and will be opened for walking, bicycling, skating, and socializing.

Music, food, and children's activities will be featured at entertainment hubs along the route at Pacific Avenue and 3rd Street, Pacific Avenue and 21st Street, and Willow Street and Magnolia Avenue.

Open Street events promote the pursuit of innovative strategies to achieve environmental, social, economic, and public health goals. By repurposing streets for cyclists, pedestrians, and other non-motorized users, cities are encouraged to consider other ways streets can be used.

Bike Share bicycles will be available for City Councilmembers and their adult family members. However, child bicycles and baby seats are not available.
