**Subject:** **Civic Center First Street Pedestrian Pathway Closure – Effective February 8, 2019**

In connection with the Main Library closure and associated construction progress, the Civic Center First Street pedestrian pathway will close starting Friday, February 8, 2019. While closed, construction fencing will be installed and remain in place during the Main Library demolition and construction of the new Lincoln Park. The new Lincoln Park site is anticipated to open in 2021.

The Cedar Avenue pedestrian pathway between the Civic Center Plaza and Broadway is anticipated to re-open in March 2019.

Information about this closure and other construction milestones are shared through the City's Change Management process. Change Ambassadors representing each Department meet with the Civic Center team monthly to receive project updates to communicate to their Department. Please continue to engage with Change Ambassador representatives for future project updates.

A map of the closure is attached and will be disseminated to City staff through the Change Ambassadors, Administrative Officers, and intranet.


