

Main Runway 12/30 Late Night Closures Through November 3rd


Due to necessary maintenance activities, Runway 12/30 will be closed nightly (seven days per week) beginning on Monday, October 10, and will last through Thursday, November 3. The nightly closures will begin at 10:00 pm and end at 6:15 am each morning. The construction/maintenance activities are being conducted seven days per week to ensure that every effort is made in order to return the runway to normal operational status as soon as possible. Runway 7L/25R will be used for operations each night during this time

and over 1,000 expected participants. The last day to sign up to be a host for you block is Friday, October 21st. If you are interested or would like more information please email info@welovelb.org!



Wayfinding Signage Program Survey






Surfrider Fundraiser: Shipwrecked!

JetBlue Q3 Exceedance Summary Lists \$30K of Runway 25R Fines

With the nighttime closure of Runway 12/30, we have been asked if JetBlue would still be subject to fines when landing on Runway 25R. The answer is yes, and the attached [report](#) indicates it's already happened. From Aug. 3rd to Sept. 14th, JetBlue had a total of 9 past curfew operations on 25R. This resulted in a fines totaling \$30,000. Combined with fines from the main runway, the Q3 total was \$132,300.
