Past Events

Cambodia Town Cultural Festival

On Sunday, I stopped by the 9th Annual Cambodia Town Cultural Festival at the Mark Twain Library. Festivities included musical performances, a costume contest, food vendors, information booths and a raffle. Representatives from the Midtown Business Improvement District (aka MPBOA) and United Cambodian Community (UCC) were on hand to provide information about their organizations.

JetBlue Fined \$72,000 for March Noise Violations

The LGB Noise Office has reviewed JetBlue late-night operations

and violations for the month of March. All of the data is preliminary pending the final verification of times, noise levels and unanticipated delay status. JetBlue conducted 17 operations after 11:00 pm. 12 of these operations resulted in Consent Decree violations/fines. For the month of March, each Consent Decree violation resulted in a fine of \$6,000. Of these 17 operations conducted after 11:00 pm, five (29%) were conducted within the 5-minute grace period, six (35%) were delayed due to poor weather conditions, five (29%) were delayed due to mechanical issues and one (6%) was delayed due to an air traffic control issue. In addition, JetBlue conducted a total of 34 operations in between 10:00 pm and 11:00 pm. 32 of these operations qualified as unanticipated delays. Two operations that were conducted in between 10:00 pm and 11:00 pm resulted in fine of \$300 per violation. Of the 34 operations that were conducted in between 10:00 pm and 11:00 pm, six (18%) were conducted within the 5-minute grace period, six (18%) were delayed due to poor weather conditions, 15 (44%) were delayed due to mechanical issues and two (6%) were delayed due to air traffic control issues. JetBlue was fined a total of \$72,600 for the month of March.

Additional Outdoor Watering Day Added

On June 2, 2016 the Long Beach Board of Water Commissioners declared a Stage 1 Water Supply Shortage, rescinding the Stage 2 Water Supply Shortage ([Board Resolution WD-1353](#)). The adoption of the Stage 1 Supply Shortage means that one additional outdoor watering day will now be permitted during the hot and dry summer months. Watering is allowed on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays

from April 1 through September 30. From October 1 through March 31 when the temperature is cooler and there is more natural rainfall, watering will only be allowed on Tuesdays and Saturdays. All other restrictions previously in effect under Stage 2 remain in effect and are listed on the Water Department's [website](#).

Below is an 1925 photo of the Ford dealership that was located at 2641 E. Anaheim St. In those days, the location at Anaheim & Ohio was practically a "factory showroom". The Ford assembly plant was located less than 5 miles west on Anaheim Street at Henry Ford Avenue.
