LBDP Receives \$100K Grant from the ABC

Long Beach Police Department has been awarded a \$100,000 grant from the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) to battle alcohol-related crime. The grant is one of 51 awarded in California to local law enforcement agencies through ABC's Alcohol Policing Partnership Program. The program is designed to put bad operators out of business, keep alcohol away from minors and bring penalties such as fines, suspensions or revocations against businesses that tread on the trust of our youth and community by violating the law. Next on the Council Agenda

Tuesday, July 24th | 5 P.M. | 333 W. Ocean Blvd.

The City Council meeting is scheduled to begin at 5 p.m. in the council chambers on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 333 W. Ocean Blvd. City council meetings are broadcast live online and are also available on Channel 3 for Charter cable subscribers and Channel 21 for FIOS subscribers. Here are some of the topics that will be discussed at Tuesday's city council meeting:

- The City Council will consider a recommendation to request



City Attorney to draft an ordinance to increase the enforcement tools available for the City against party houses; including holding property owners responsible if they rent out their homes for massive gatherings that disturb neighborhoods, block the public right of way, and threaten public safety.

- The City Council will discuss a recommendation to request City Manager to report back on how the City can expand its enforcement of fireworks violations through ordinance changes, the City's ability to enhance and/or develop an administrative citation process for fireworks violations, include more technology based ways of reporting fireworks violation, evaluate the possibility of utilizing video to enforce violations, and evaluate the feasibility of video evidence of fireworks violations provided to the City by residents being used in enforcement and/or citations. Data and research compiled by the individual council offices should be utilized as a reference.
- The City Council will consider a recommendation to request City Manager to conduct an inventory of beach and park space signage to determine if we have sufficient signage, and consider changes to sign locations and messages to make them more effective.








And Finally

Congratulations Vice Mayor Dee Andrews

Tuesday night, my friend and council colleague, Dee Andrews, was elected Vice Mayor. This honor adds to Dee's leadership legacy that began 60 years ago when he was elected as the first African American student body president of Poly High School. The photo below is from his football days at Long Beach State. He was inducted into the CSULB Hall of Fame in 1990 for both his football and track accomplishments. While Dee Andrews received dozens of awards throughout his athletic career, he was never a Heisman Trophy winner. However, as shown in the photo, he definitely knew how to strike the pose.
