## Hot Topics

### Community Hospital Update

Beginning last Friday afternoon, the City conducted two incredibly productive meetings with MemorialCare. During Tuesday's meeting that included the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), MemorialCare, Molina Wu Network (MWN) and the City, a major milestone was achieved. MemorialCare agreed to formally submit a letter to CDPH with a request to "suspend" the hospital license so that the City can have a "continuously licensed" facility while MWN works on securing their own license to operate the hospital. The following day, we received a copy of MemorialCare's letter that included the great news that MemorialCare rescinded an earlier request to surrender their license and replaced it with a notice to suspend their license. CDPH has stated this suspension is valid for a full year. A copy of the letter is available at this [link](#).



We now have a clear path to saving Community Hospital. The State organizations are all on the same page as to what needs to be accomplished to reopen the hospital under MWN's hospital license. While the application for licensure must be completed by MWN, the City stands ready to help facilitate that process.

The response area for Station 10 includes the 4th council district neighborhoods west of Obispo Avenue. Captain Rosa also served at the LBFD Training Center in CD4 as a Training Captain. Last year, for the months that Station 10 was being remodeled, Engine 10 responded out of Station 17 in our council district. Captain David Rosa faithfully served the residents of the 4th council district and the entire city of Long Beach. On June 25, 2018, he made the ultimate sacrifice while serving our community.
