## Hot Topics

### Community Hospital Update

The Community Hospital re-opening plan will be coming to a City Council closed session next Tuesday. City staff will provide an update on lease negotiations and request City Council direction on next steps. The proposed agreement will then be presented in a public meeting of the City Council in December. The Molina Wu Network, operators of the new hospital, have completed and submitted nearly 100 percent of the re-licensing application with the State. Upon approval, the groundwork will be laid for the State inspection process to begin. This is an exciting development!

## LGB Requests Approval to Eliminate "Slot Squatting"

A new LGB policy that will require greater utilization of air carrier flight slots will be coming to city council for approval on Tuesday. The purpose of the new rule is to eliminate "slot squatting" where an air carrier does not utilize their allocated slots. This agenda item is not related to the Noise Ordinance proposal to mitigate late night curfew violations. 
## Upcoming Events

## Next on the Council Agenda

November 20th | 5 p.m. | 333 W. Ocean Blvd.

The City Council meeting is scheduled to begin at 5 p.m. in the council chambers on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 333 W. Ocean Blvd. City council meetings are broadcast live online here and are also available on Channel 3 for Charter cable subscribers and Channel 21 for FIOS subscribers. Here are some

of the topics that will be discussed at Tuesday's city council meeting:

- The City Council will consider a recommendation to adopt resolution redeclaring a shelter crisis; suspending applicable provisions of local law, including those contained in the City's zoning ordinances and regulations; and, authorizing the operation of a winter shelter, for the period of December 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019, inclusive; and Authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute a Lease, including any necessary documents and amendments, with the United States Veterans Initiative (Lessee), for approximately 7,318 rentable square feet of space at 5571 Orange Avenue for use as a winter shelter.
- The City Council will discuss a recommendation to adopt resolution amending Resolution No. C-28465 with respect to the utilization of flight slots allocated at the Long Beach Airport and related administrative amendments to the Resolution, in accordance with the Airport Noise Compatibility Ordinance set forth in Chapter 16.43 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

### The Palace Hotel About to Turn 90

In the "helmet and bike lock" item above, we referenced the LINC housing's The Palace Apartments. Built in 1929, The Palace is an historic, two-story building located at 2640 E. Anaheim Street in the 4th council district. LINC Housing restored and renovated the Palace Hotel to serve as a home to transitional age emancipated foster youth, 18-24

years old, one of the most vulnerable populations in our county. The Palace has achieved a LEED Platinum certification. The east side of the hotel can be seen at the far left in the early 1930's photo below.
