



The Original Los Altos Center

The retail buildings on the west side of Bellflower Blvd., between Stearns and Abbeyfield, were the original Los Altos storefronts. In fact, the stores were built five years prior to the opening of the Los Altos Shopping Center. East of Bellflower, Sears (originally Walkers and The Broadway) is the only store remaining from the original shopping center. West of Bellflower, a Goodyear store, Hof's Hut, See's Candies and a gas station have been in continuous operation for over 60 years.
