

Community Hospital Update

Last week, we anticipated having a city council vote on a property agreement at our closed session. Instead, we were able to find a way to continue negotiations with Molina, Wu, Network LLC (MWN) for another two weeks. This will put us on track for a possible closed session vote on March 5th. The City will still meet the state legislative deadline by introducing a "spot bill" today (Friday). This bill will serve as a placeholder until we are able to execute a property agreement with MWN. Upon reaching an agreement, the bill will then be amended to include the negotiated terms. Again, because the City is still in real estate negotiations with MWN, we cannot provide any details of the agreement at this time.




And Finally
