



Next on the Council Agenda

July 16th | 5 pm | 333 W. Ocean Blvd.

The City Council meeting will start at 5 p.m. in the council chamber on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 333 W. Ocean Blvd. City council meetings are broadcast live online and are also available on Channel 3 for Charter cable subscribers and Channel 21 for FIOS subscribers. The following topic is one of the items on the agenda:



- The city council will consider a recommendation to declare ordinance amending Title 21, Zoning, of the Long Beach Municipal Code to: (1) create a definition for "drive-through facilities;" (2) update the commercial and industrial zones permitted use tables with the new "drive-through facility" use; (3) require a Conditional Use Permit for new drive-throughs and expansions of existing drive-throughs in all industrial, commercial, and planned development zones; and, (4) provide new required findings specific to the drive-through use, read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading.
- The city council will discuss a recommendation to adopt resolution calling for the

placement of a General Tax Measure on the Ballot of the March 3, 2020 Special Municipal Election for submission to the qualified voters of the City an amended ordinance to extend and adjust the rate of a Transactions and Use Tax, and making findings of fiscal emergency pursuant to California Proposition 218.

- The city council will consider a recommendation to receive and file the application of Navsher Singh, dba Loma Mini Market, for an original application of an Alcoholic Beverage Control License, at 1600 Loma Avenue; and, determine the application serves the public convenience and necessity.





And Finally

Baseball at Shell Park near Redondo and Stearns

With all the talk about the Angels coming to town, they would not be the first Major League Baseball team to play in Long Beach. The World Series Champion Pittsburgh Pirates played an exhibition game in 1926 near the intersection of Redondo and Stearns. That's

where the 3,500-seat Shell Park baseball stadium was located. It was built in 1922 to be the home of the Shell Oilers baseball team that was made up of Shell Oil employees who worked the oil fields when they weren't playing baseball. Babe Ruth and Lou Gehrig almost made an appearance at Shell Park on October 30, 1927, but the exhibition game was rained out. The aerial photo below, taken 3 days later on November 2, 1927, clearly shows the field and its proximity to Stearns Street. There are also a number of great photos (samples below) in Tom Meigs' book "Baseball in Long Beach" available at the Los Altos Library.
