

Gas Pipeline Replacement Project Near Minnie Gant

Long Beach Energy Resources (LBER) will be starting a gas main and gas service pipeline replacement project near Minnie Gant School. The work will be on Britton Drive from Atherton Street to Los Santos Drive, and on Marita Street from Britton Drive to Fanwood Avenue. The project start date is next Monday, July 22nd, and the work hours will be 7:00 am to 4:30 pm. The estimated duration of the project is 60 business days. However, LBER is aware the school's start date is August 28th, and they plan on completing the work on Britton Drive prior to the start of the school year.
