El Dorado Nature Center Fire

Yesterday at noon, we received an update from Fire Chief, Xavier Espino, on the Nature Center brush fires that took place Wednesday afternoon:

- Multiple fires with approx. 2-3 acres of brush affected and no structure involvement.
- At times, LBFD personnel deployed was equal to a 2nd alarm assignment.
- Automatic aid from Orange County Fire Authority included an engine company,

Battalion Chief and water dropping helicopter.

- Automatic aid from Los Angeles County Fire Dept. included a hand crew (wildland) who completed overhaul including limbing some trees. Initial thoughts to fell multiple trees were discarded.
- Fires are currently under investigation by LBFD Fire Investigators.

After the fire investigation is completed, we will work to support their fire prevention recommendations. 




Summer is here and Los Altos Library is breaking out the popcorn for a free family-friendly film every Friday! Join them Friday, June 28th for **Mama Mia!**

June 28th | 8 pm | 5620 Atherton St.


