Community Hospital Update

It's been a little over two weeks since the City Council voted on a key item to save Community Hospital. If you'll recall, on March 12, the Council authorized the City Manager to enter into an interim lease agreement with MWN for Community Hospital. Since that time, the City's team has been hard at work. I'm pleased to share that this week, we've reached **two major** milestones: (1) the Interim Lease Agreement between the City and MWN has been executed; and (2) the City has formally submitted our seismic extension request to the California Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD). These are two really big steps in the right direction. We'll update you next week with more information as it comes.



2nd Annual Grand Prix 5k



Next on the Council Agenda

April 2nd | 5 pm | 333 W. Ocean Blvd

The City Council meeting will start at 5 p.m. in the council chamber on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 333 W. Ocean Blvd. City council meetings are broadcast live online and are also available on Channel 3 for Charter cable subscribers and Channel 21 for FIOS subscribers. Here are a few topics that will be discussed at Tuesday's city council meeting:



- The Council will consider a recommendation to receive and file the 2018 Report on Tenant Assistance Policies; Direct City Attorney to prepare a Tenant Relocation Assistance Ordinance implementing Recommendation One, utilizing the Baseline Relocation Assistance Components and Applicability Requirement Option Two; and Direct City Manager to take the necessary steps to implement Recommendations Two through Five, as presented.
- The Council will discuss a recommendation to adopt a Minute Order declaring a citywide moratorium on accepting applications for new drive-through lanes at any new or existing business establishments; direct City Manager to have the Department of Development Services and the Planning Commission review the development standards for drive-through lanes and make recommendations to the City Council; and, request City Attorney to prepare an interim (moratorium) ordinance pursuant to Chapter 21.50 of the Long Beach Municipal Code for notice and placement on the City Council agenda for hearing at its third meeting following adoption of this Minute Order.
- The Council will consider a Recommendation to authorize City Manager, or designee, to enter into a Grant Agreement with Community Hospital Long Beach Foundation, a Long Beach-based nonprofit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000, for reimbursement of predevelopment costs incurred by the City of Long Beach to rebuild and replace buildings located at 1720 Termino Avenue, 1760 Termino Avenue, and 4111 East Willow Street (Subject Property), to continue to operate an acute care hospital at the site; and Adopt resolution authorizing City Manager, or designee, to execute an agreement with Perkins + Will, a private for-profit corporation in Los Angeles, CA, for hospital facility architectural design and consulting services, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.
- The Council will discuss a recommendation to increase appropriations in the General Fund (GF) in the Public Works Department (PW) in the amount of \$13,000, offset by the Fourth Council District one-time District Priority Funds transferred from the General Fund (GF) in the Citywide Activities Department (XC) to support the installation of Driver Feedback Signs on Stearns Street; and Decrease appropriations in the General Fund (GF) in the Citywide Activities Department (XC) to offset a transfer to the Public Works Department (PW).
