



And Finally

From Walker's to The Broadway to Sears

It was 64 years ago this month, November 1955, that Walker's Department Store opened in the new Los Altos Shopping Center. Just a year later, the store was sold and rebranded as The Broadway. In 1963, a third story was added, and The Broadway ended up serving as the anchor store of the shopping center for 40 years. In November 1995, a month after purchasing 82-store Broadway chain, Federated Department Stores announced the Los Altos store was being sold to Sears. The conversion to Sears was completed the following year, and the newly remodeled shopping center opened with a new anchor store. We don't know what the future holds for Sears, but we will share any information we receive.
