SWEEPING BEST PRACTICES

DID YOU KNOW SWEEPING DEBRIS IN THE GUTTER IS ILLEGAL? HERE ARE SOME OTHER STREET SWEEPING TIPS YOU MAY NOT KNOW.



Do not rake, blow, sweep, or pile leaves or other debris into the street, alley, or gutter. Disposing of anything in the gutter, including leaves, is a violation of federal law. Additionally, street sweepers have difficulty removing piles of debris.



Dispose of litter properly, keeping it out of gutters and alleys.



Keep the street in front of your home dry on street sweeping days. Street sweepers are not as effective when the street is overly wet.



Never pour oil, antifreeze, or any other hazardous materials in the street, gutter, or alley.

LBFD Responding in CD4 Sixty Years Ago

On Halloween day sixty years ago, the Shell Oil Company building at 2080 Obispo Avenue caught fire. While many associate the area with Signal Hill, it is actually in the City of Long Beach, the 4th council district and in Engine 17's response area. In 1959, the area was

mostly oil wells and oil storage tanks that posed a serious fire threat. The vintage photo from the LBFD archives shows a hose crew on the roof spraying water on the flames while a firefighter on a fully extended ladder pipe sprays water downward. At right, firefighters use an axe to vent the roof while others climb short ladders to get to the second story of the wooden structure. Sixty years ago, East Long Beach fire crews may not have had the 405 Freeway and multi-story buildings to contend with, but they certainly had plenty of potential fire threats to keep them busy.
