Hot Topics

Friday the 13th + Full Moon + Harvest Moon = Rare Event

Tonight, we'll experience a full moon on Friday the 13th. It is a rare event that happens on average every 20 years. The last time the full moon fell on Friday the 13th was on June 13, 2014, and the next time will have to wait until August 13, 2049. However, tonight's Friday the 13th full "Harvest Moon", a full moon closest to the autumn equinox is much rarer event. The last time the Northern Hemisphere's full Harvest Moon fell on a Friday the 13th was in the year 1935, and the next time won't be until the year 2171.



Regarding Friday the 13th being associated with bad luck, my personal experience is that it exceeds 50-year spans. I broke my arm on the football field of Wilson High School on Friday, September 13, 1968. So far today, I haven't had any mishaps.





And Finally

Holsum Bread in the Heart of Zaferia

With "disaster preparedness" the topic of our next community meeting, images of the 1933 earthquake always come to mind. The crumpled building in the photo below stood at 1201 Redondo Avenue, just south of Anaheim Street. The photo is from the LBFD archives that include many earthquake aftermath images. Just last week, I discovered photos of the original building in the LBPL digital archives. The three story structure was home to the Long Beach Baking Company that produced Holsum Bread. It opened around the same time as Community Hospital in 1924. Interesting architectural features include wooden pergolas built on an open air balcony.
