

The City Council meeting will start at 5 pm in the Bob Foster Civic Chambers on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 411 W. Ocean Blvd. City council meetings are broadcast live online and are also available on Channel 3 for Charter cable subscribers and Channel 21 for FIOS subscribers. Here are some topics that appear on next Tuesday's agenda:

- Recommendation to declare ordinance amending the Long Beach Municipal Code by amending Section 2.02.010, relating to electronic filing of campaign disclosure statements, read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading.
- Recommendation to declare ordinance amending the Long Beach Municipal Code by amending Sections 8.63.020 and 8.63.030; all relating to prohibiting the use and sale of single-use food and beverage containers, packaging and food service ware made of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam, rigid polystyrene #6, and non-recyclable and non-compostable material for prepared food distribution, and the distribution of plastic or bio-plastic straws, read and adopted as read.
