



Referral List for Court Mandated HIV/AIDS Health Education Classes

Be advised that as of January 1, 2018, the City of Long Beach Department of Health and Human Services is **NO LONGER offering** Court Mandated HIV/AIDS Education Classes. Clients in need of the court mandated HIV/AIDS health education classes may contact the following organizations:

1. BIENESTAR LB, call (562) 438-5800 ask for Hector Montes for more information. There is a one-time HIV 101 class. Participants that identify as MSM and transgender must attend a series of 5 classes to receive a certificate of completion. Classes are by appointment, please call to schedule classes. There is a \$50.00 fee for the class/es and NO FEE for HIV testing. Bienestar address is 1464 Cherry Avenue, Long Beach, CA 90813.
2. LA CADA, call (562) 906-2676 ask for Lawrence Fernandez at extension 118. Ask for the "HISTORIAS Program". Classes are by appointment only, please allow at least 2 hours for your appointment. There is a \$50.00 charge for the class and HIV test. Clients need to take their ID and attend the class alone. Spanish services are limited. LA CADA address is 11015 Bloomfield Ave, Santa Fe Springs, CA 90670.
3. THE (To Help Everyone) Health & Wellness Centers, Inc. call (323) 730-1920 ask for Danny at extension 3027. You do not need an appointment for the classes. There is **NO FEE** for the classes. Free HIV testing is available also. THE address is 3834 S. Western Ave, Los Angeles, CA 90062.
4. JWCH (John Wesley Community Health) Institute, Inc. call Roxanne at (213) 253-8245 for the schedule. **Classes are for females only.** Participants must attend 4 sessions to receive certificate of completion. There is **NO FEE** for the classes. Free HIV testing is available also. JWCH address is 522 S. San Pedro, Los Angeles, CA 90013.
5. APAIT, call (213) 375-3830 ask for Jeffrey Liang at extension 1819 or email at jeffreyl@apaitonline.org. Courses are by appointment only. There is a \$50.00 charge for the course and HIV testing. Their HIV/AIDS Education courses are offered in a variety of Asian and other languages, including Arabic, Armenian, Cantonese, Farsi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Mandarin, Russian, **Spanish**, Tagalog, Thai and Vietnamese. Let Jeffrey know if any language interpretation will be needed. Classes are held at APAIT 3055 Wilshire Blvd., 3rd Floor, Los Angeles, CA 90010.
6. BIENESTAR East Los Angeles, call (866) 590-6411 x107 ask for Sylvia Valerio for more information. There is a one-time HIV 101 class. Participants that identify as MSM and transgender female must attend a series of 5 classes to receive a certificate of completion. Prostitution Diversion Program (PDP) classes are also available. Classes are by appointment, please call to schedule classes. There is a \$50.00 fee for the class/es and NO FEE for HIV testing. **Spanish** speaking classes are available. Bienestar East LA address is 5326 E. Beverly Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90022.
7. Ventura County Public Health, call (805) 652-5902 for a recording or call Rene Posada at (805) 652-3342 for more information. English speaking classes are on the 1st Wednesday of every month and **Spanish** speaking classes are on the 3rd Wednesday of every month. All classes are from 5:30 to 6:30 pm. You do not need to register, just show up. There is **NO FEE** for the class. Free HIV testing is also available with rapid testing results in 20 minutes or blood test.
