



## Clinician In Jail Program

- Pilot Program: April to September 2018
  - **297** Individuals Seen in Jail
  - **106** Interactions with Clients
  - **214** Referrals Provided
  - **104** Repeated Contacts

## City Prosecutor - Priority Access Diversion Program (PAD 2.0)

- Pre-trial diversion for individuals with mental health or substance abuse challenges
  - 42 Individuals referred through the Clinician in Jail Program
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## Government User Integrated Diversion Enhancement System (GUIDES)

- Currently under development
  - GUIDES will equip first responders with needed information to quickly identify clients
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## Rising Scholars, Education Lab

- Education lab offers peer support to obtain high school diploma, GED, AA, BA or MA degrees
  - Panel discussions
  - Mentor programs
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## Data Warehouse

- Unified infrastructure for linking and accessing citywide data
  - Police, Fire and Health administrative datasets
  - Data analysis pipeline to extract, clean, transform, and analyze Justice Lab client data
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The Justice Lab received **\$1,048,000** in grant funding from the **Laura and John Arnold Foundation** to support the City's Data-Driven Justice initiatives and the vigorous evaluation of the MDT Model .

The Police Department 2019 Fiscal Year Budget includes **\$100,000** of one-time funds from the **General Fund** to extend jail clinician services for one year.

The Health Department in partnership with the Police Department was awarded **\$50,000** in funding from the **John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation** Innovation Safety Challenge.
