About the Project

Victory/Santa Cruz Park was deeded to the City in 1889 and formally declared and dedicated for public park purposes in 1980. The linear park extends one mile on the south side of Ocean Boulevard from Golden Avenue to Alamitos Avenue. The guidelines were last adopted in 1989 and need to be updated to better reflect the transformation of the Downtown over the past 30 years.
