

ORDERS FOR RELIEF

Victims of domestic violence and sexual assaults have the right to petition the Superior Court for any of the following orders for relief:

1. An order restraining the attacker from abusing the victim and other family members.
2. An order directing the attacker to leave the household.
3. An order preventing the attacker from entering the residence, school, business, or victim's place of employment.
4. An order awarding custody of or visitation with a minor child or children.
5. An order restraining the attacker from molesting or interfering with minor children in the custody of the victim.
6. An order directing the party not granted custody to pay support of the minor children if they have a legal obligation to do so.
7. An order directing the defendant to make specified debt payments which will be due while the order is in effect.
8. An order directing the defendant to participate in counseling.

CITIZEN'S ARREST

Victims of domestic violence and sexual assaults have the right to a citizen's arrest. The police officer presenting the victim with this resource guide shall advise the victim how to safely carry out a citizen's arrest.

CIVIL LAWSUIT

Victims of domestic violence, hate crimes, and sexual assaults, have the right to file a civil suit for losses suffered as a result of abuse, including medical expenses, loss of earnings, damage to property, and any other related expense incurred by the victim or agency that shelters the victim.

STRANGULATION

Victims of strangulation should know that this could cause internal injuries and you are encouraged to seek medical attention.

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER (TRO)

Procedure for filing at the Long Beach Superior Court:

1st Floor Clerk's Office, Room 1200, Window #1-4

 Hours: 8:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

1. Visit the Clerk's Office to request a Domestic Violence TRO packet or proceed directly to Legal Aid (see below) for free legal assistance.
2. Fill out all forms and go to the filing window #1-4 where a clerk will assign a case number.
3. Wait in the waiting room in room 1200 until a clerk calls your name.
4. If a judge grants your request, you will obtain an immediate Ex Parte Order.
5. If granted the clerk will provide you two (2) copies, one for the defendant and one for yourself.
6. If you have the Sheriffs Office serve the Order, you will need the following: one copy of application #DV-100, one copy of the TRO, and form #DV-110.
7. Keep your copy of the TRO with you at all times.

LEGAL AID CLINIC - Legal Aid staff will be in the Long Beach Courthouse, 1st Floor, Room 1004, on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, intake at 9:00 a.m. Clients are seen on a first come, first serve basis. All services are free of charge.
