***WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAIM'S ACTIVITY
FISCAL YEAR 2017***

The Workers' Compensation Division consists of attorneys who handle the litigated claims and claim's staff who are responsible for providing medical and indemnity benefits to injured employees covered by the City's Self Insured and Self-Administered Workers' Compensation Program.

Workers' Compensation benefits are administered pursuant to California Workers' Compensation laws. The Workers' Compensation division continues to work closely with City Departments, Risk Management and Return to Work coordinators to improve service and monitor and reduce costs.

The reports here summarize Workers' Compensation Claims Count by Department and Costs Incurred by Department for the City's Fiscal Year 2017, which began on October 1, 2016 and ended on September 30, 2017. The costs reflect indemnity and medical benefits by department through September 30, 2017. Safety Officers receive enhanced benefits under the Workers' Compensation laws and are the top cost drivers.

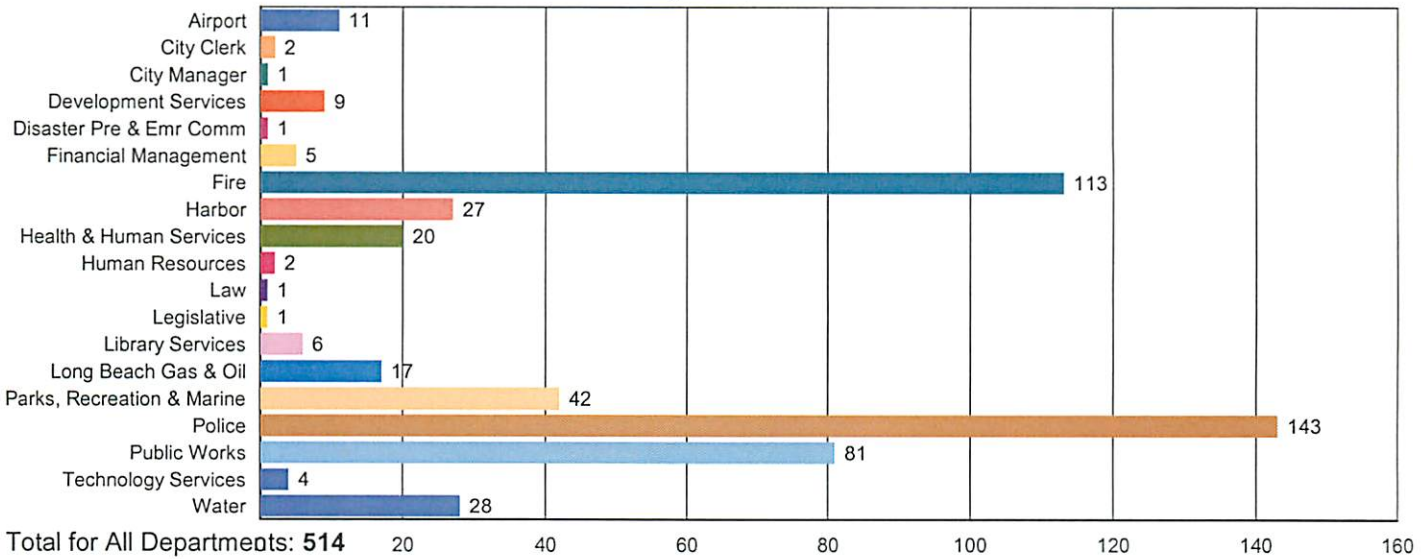

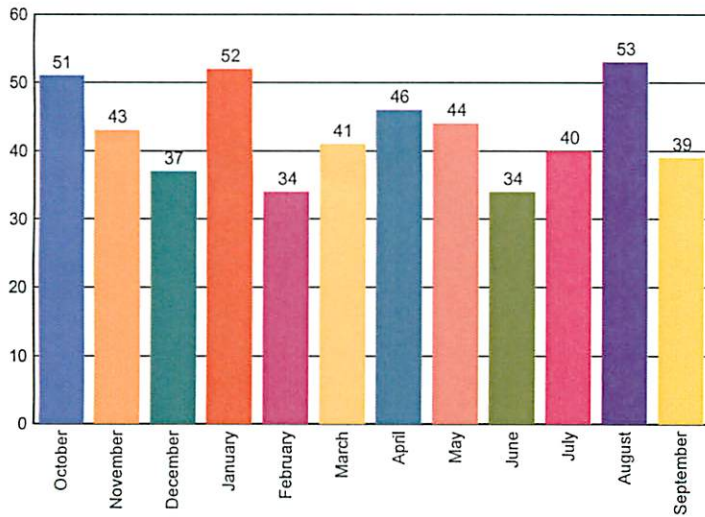

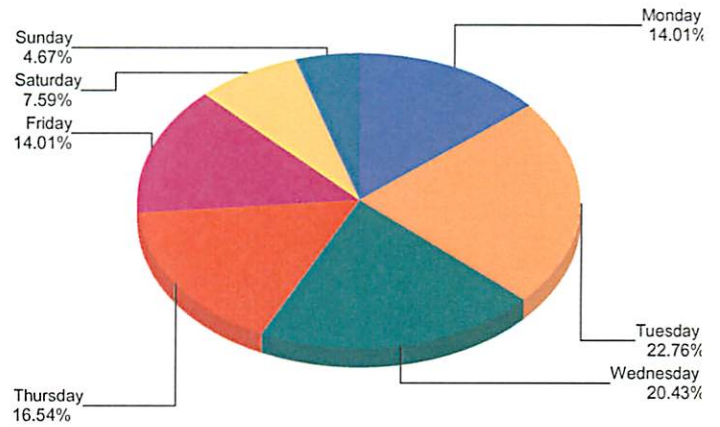
Count by Department



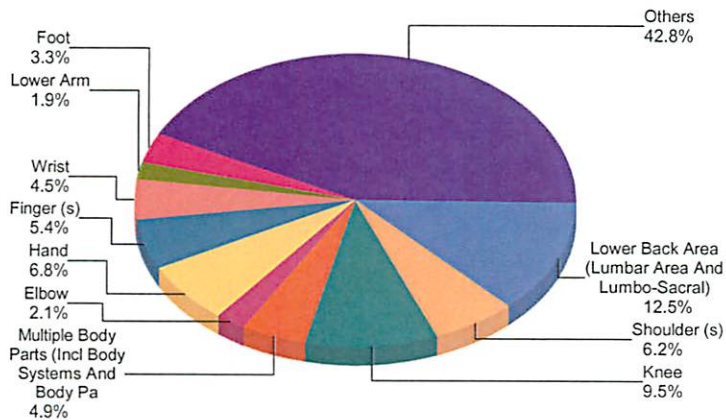
Claims per Month



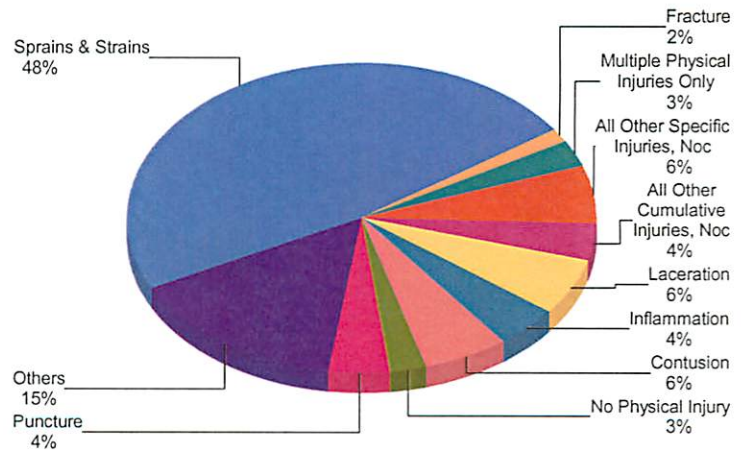
Percentage by Day of Week

Top 10 Nature of Injuries

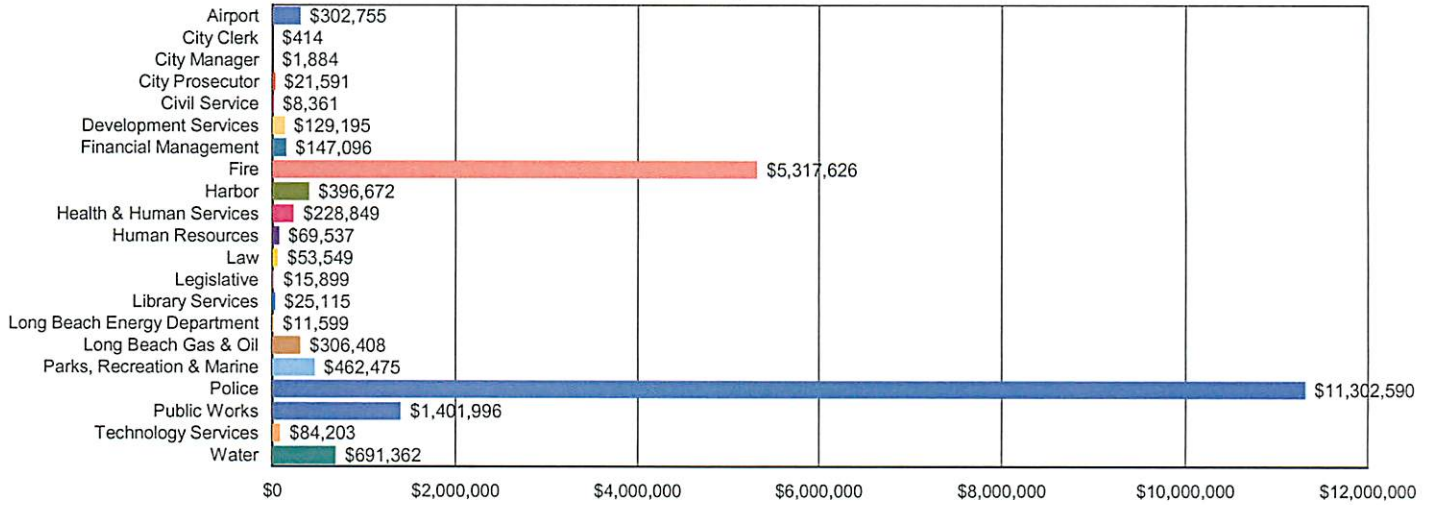

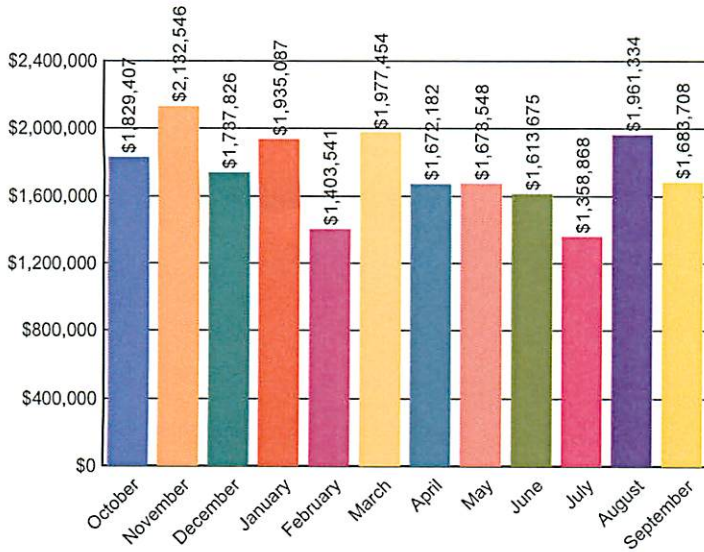

Cost Incurred by Department

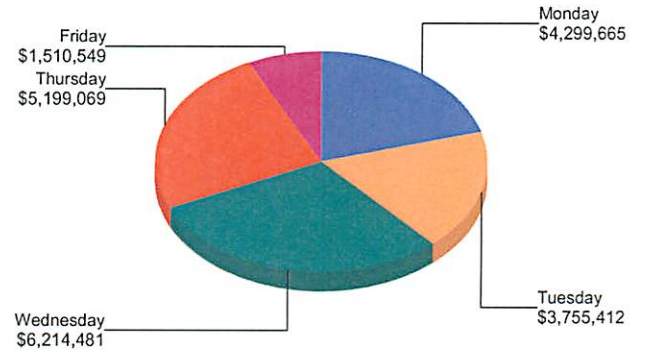

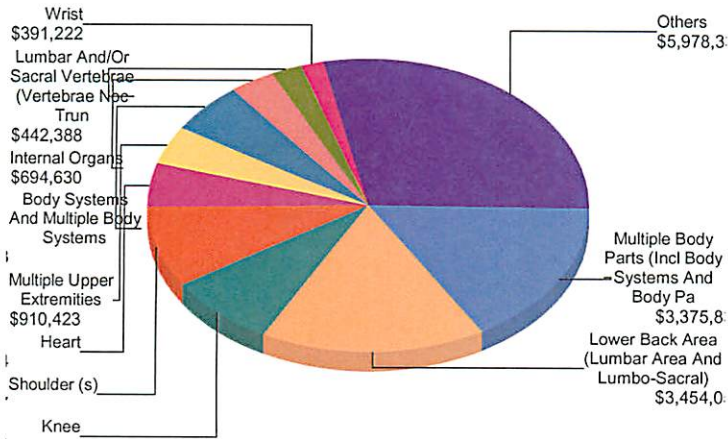
Cost Incurred per Month
