Jan 1, 2023	Dec 31, 2024	Election Cycle for November 5, 2024 General Municipal Election. (LBMC § 2.01.210(B))
Apr 9, 2024		Adopt Resolutions- City Council to adopt resolutions declaring the results for March 5, 2024 Priminary Nominating Election and calling for the General Municipal Election on November 5, 2024.
Jul 30, 2024		Change of Ballot Designation - Last day that any nominated candidate may request in writing a different ballot designation than used at the March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election. (E.C. § 13107 (e))
Jul 31, 2024		Semi-annual campaign statement due (Form 460) covering the period January 1, 2024 - June 30, 2024.
Aug 9, 2024		Candidate Statements - Last day for candidates to file statement other than the one used at the March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election. (E.C. § 13307)
Aug 10, 2024	Aug 19, 2024	Public Examination Period - During this period, candidate statements, candidate names and ballot designations shall be open to public examination. Any person may challenge the aforementioned candidate information by filing a petition for writ of mandate no later than August 19, 2024. (E.C. § 13313)
Aug 15, 2024		Randomized Alpha Draw -- Secretary of State to determine order of names on ballot. (LBMC § 1.21.060, E.C. § 13113).
Aug 16, 2024		Last day for City Clerk to trasmit the names of qualified candidates to County elections official. (E.C. § 10403)
Sep 4, 2024	Sep 6, 2024	Transliteration Review Period - First and last day candidates may review transliteration of their names. Requests for changes must be submitted to the County elections official no later than the last day of the review period
Sep 26, 2024		1st Pre-Election Statement Due - Last day to file 1st pre-election campaign statement (Form 460) covering the period July 1, 2024 to September 21, 2024. (G.C. § 84200.8)
Sep 26, 2024	Oct 15, 2024	Mailing of Official Sample Ballot Booklets - An Official Sample Ballot Booklet shall be mailed to each voter in the jurisdiction no later than 21 days before the election. (E.C. § 13303)

Oct 7, 2024		Mailing of Vote by Mail Ballots - No later than 29 days before the day of the election, the county elections official shall begin mailing the materials required by Section 3010. (E.C. §§ 3001(b) and 3206)
Oct 24, 2024		2nd Pre-Election Statement Due - Last day to file 2nd pre-election campaign statement (Form 460) covering the period September 22, 2024 - October 19, 2024. (G.C. § 84200.8)
Oct 26, 2024	Nov 5, 2024	Vote Centers Voting Period - First Day Vote Centers open beginning 10 days prior the election day. A vote Center election may be conducted pursuant to E.C. § 4007(6). (11 Days Vote Centers)
Nov 1, 2024		3rd pre-election statement due covering period October 20, 2024 - October 30, 2024. (LBMC 2.01.720)
Nov 2, 2024		4 Days Vote Centers open.
Nov 5, 2024		Election Day Polls open 7:00 a.m., close 8:00 p.m. (E.C. §§ 1304, 10541 and 14212)
Dec 5, 2024		Completion of Official Canvass. (E.C. § 15372) Note: On December 2, 2024, the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On December 3, 2024, the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election officially concluded.
Dec 17, 2024		Candidates elected to office shall assume such office on the third Tuesday in December. (LBMC § 1.15.010)
Dec 31, 2024		Election Cycle Ends December 31, 2024. (LBMC § 1.15.30)
Jan 31, 2025		Semi-annual campaign statement due (Form 460) covering the period November 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024.
Mar 1, 2025		Disposal of Surplus Funds. Funds must be expended no later than sixty (60) days after the end of the Election Cycle.
