3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
5 MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 16.16.140
6 RELATING TO PROHIBITING ADULTS NOT
7 ACCOMPANYING CHILDREN AGES 12 AND UNDER FROM
8 PARK PLAYGROUNDS

10 WHEREAS, City of Long Beach (“City”) adopted Ordinance No. ORD-22-
11 0014 on May 10, 2022 to establish “Kids Zones” which prohibit adults not accompanying
12 children under the age of 12 from park playgrounds; and

13 WHEREAS, safe outdoor spaces are vital to the healthy development of
14 children, as they provide exercise and recreation areas, emotional and social enrichment
15 opportunities, and promote community use of public green spaces; and

16 WHEREAS, in playground design, everything from the height of the structure
17 to the type of surfacing used is based on guidelines that reflect use by toddlers and children
18 aged 2 to 5 and/or 5 to 12 years old; and

19 WHEREAS, adult use of playground equipment can result in structural
20 damage that may lead to safety hazards for the children who use the equipment after them;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, residents of the City have reported adults misusing public
23 playground spaces by engaging in other activities that discourage proper use by children
24 and their guardians; and

25 WHEREAS, given the recent upticks in vandalism and damage, and resident
26 concerns about the safety and availability of the City’s playgrounds to children, it is
27 necessary for the City to continue to promote measures for safe outdoor spaces; and

28 WHEREAS, City’s current “Kids Zones” at park playgrounds prohibit adults

1 not accompanying children under the age of 12 from being present, which sought to ensure
2 the City's playground equipment and play areas specifically designed for children remain
3 safe and available spaces for use by children of the aforementioned age groups; and

4 WHEREAS, kids zones would be easily identifiable and enforceable with
5 signage identifying the zone area; and

6 WHEREAS, kids zones would not cover other non-playground public spaces
7 in parks, including, but not limited to, benches, fields, and restrooms; and

8 WHEREAS, in establishing Ordinance No. ORD-22-0014, City followed suit
9 of other jurisdictions in California, New York, Oregon, Colorado, and Florida, in an effort to
10 preserve such spaces and equipment for children for which they were intended; and

11 WHEREAS, City signage in park playgrounds provide that such equipment
12 is for the use of children ages 5 to 12; and

13 WHEREAS, City desires to include children of the age of 12 to Section
14 16.16.140 in order to be consistent with the manufacturer's recommendations for
15 appropriate use of playground equipment and current operational practices at park
16 playgrounds;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as
18 follows:

20 Section 1. Section 16.16.140 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby
21 amended to read as follows:

22 16.16.140 Park Playgrounds - Adults not accompanying children ages 12 and
23 under prohibited.

24 A. No adult shall be present on any City park playground unless
25 the adult is accompanying a child or children age 12 and under, lawfully under
26 their custody or control, including a parent or guardian, babysitter, caretaker
27 or other designee of a parent or guardian having sole or joint supervisory
28 responsibility over the child, using such playground.

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B. "Park playground" or "playground" for purposes of this Section means any park area which has been designated by the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine Director, or designee, as a "Kids Zone", and on which clear and visible signage has been posted providing notice of such "Kids Zone" status and the prohibition in Subsection A.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.




