

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Long Beach City Council will hold a public hearing to consider an Economic Development Subsidy in conformance with California Government Code, Section 53083.

Project Description: The Long Beach City Council will consider an Economic Development Subsidy in connection with a Transient Occupancy Tax Sharing Agreement with Breakers Development, LLC, in connection with a Transient Occupancy Tax Sharing Agreement for the property located at 210 East Ocean Boulevard, pursuant to California Government Code, Section 53083. The Economic Development Subsidy will support the adaptive reuse of a historic structure in the downtown Long Beach area by transforming the vacant and underutilized building into an upscale boutique hotel and spa.
