

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Long Beach will conduct a public hearing to adopt the resolution amending the Master Fee and Charges Schedule on September 3, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at 411 West Ocean Blvd., Long Beach, California, 90802. The City Council will consider the adoption of new fees/fee changes designed to recoup all or a portion of costs associated with specific services.

All user fees and charges in the Master Fee and Charges Schedule will be increased by the City Cost Index, a calculation of the increase in the City's cost over the previous fiscal year, except for those that have been exempted. In addition to these fee changes, some fees have been added, adjusted or deleted due to a change in service or other bases. Specifically, new fees and/or adjusted fees will be considered for the following categories of fees:

City Clerk: Passport Application Fee. Development Services: Building Fees, Construction in the Vicinity of Oil Wells and Methane Mitigation, Technology Surcharge, Short Term Rental Registration Fee. Economic Development: Enterprise Zone Program Fees. Financial Management: Parking Citations (also reported under Citywide and Public Works Departments in the Citywide Master Fee and Charges Schedule). Fire: Miscellaneous Permits and Fees. Library Services: Main Library Rental of Library Rooms, Meeting Area, and Library Equipment fees. Long Beach Airport: Airline Fees, Aircraft Parking. Long Beach Energy Resources: Engineering and Construction Support Fees for Plan Check and Meter Rooms, Replacement Cost Fee, SERRF Private Hauler Tip Fee. Parks, Recreation and Marine: Marina and Marina Slip Fees, Dry Boat Storage Wait-List Fee, Launch Ramp Card Replacement Fee, Lien Process Fee, Impound Fee for Vessels Impounded from Dry Boat Storage Areas. Police: Board-Up Fees, Electronic Extraction Fee. Public Works: Independent Hearing Fee for Small Cellular Application/ Wireless Telecommunications Appeals, Wheel Clamp Release Fee, Tree Trimming Fee, Board-Up Fees, Various Facility Fees for Guard Rail, Facility Damage Repairs or Special Events Facility Usage.
