Reported January 2020 Regarding the September 2019 Meeting

All peace officer personnel records, including information relating to specific deliberations of the Citizen Police Complaint Commission and findings by the City Manager, shall be kept confidential to the extent required by law. In order to comply with this requirement, certain information may have been withheld in this report.

After its **September 12, 2019** meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the **September 12, 2019** meeting are:

**COMMISSION**

- Sustained – 5 allegations
- Not Sustained – 7 allegations
- Exonerated - 15 allegations
- Unfounded – 41 allegations
- Other – 1 allegation

**CITY MANAGER**

- Sustained – 0 allegations
- Not Sustained – 3 allegations
- Exonerated – 18 allegations
- Unfounded – 48 allegations
- Other – 0 allegations

The Commission had concerns about searches continuing when someone is being searched by an officer of another sex without policy being clarified to the person being searched about opposite sex searches.

After its **October 10, 2019** meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the **October 10, 2019** meeting are:

- Sustained – 2 allegations
- Not Sustained – 21 allegations
- Exonerated - 8 allegations
- Unfounded – 11 allegations
- Other – 2 allegations

**CITY MANAGER**

Sustained – 1 allegation  
Not Sustained – 11 allegations  
Exonerated – 7 allegations  
Unfounded – 24 allegations  
Other – 1 allegation

The Commission submitted a recommendation to have the Long Beach Police Department retrain an officer on use of force commands. The Commission also had concerns regarding information given to the Long Beach Police Department by Panama Joe's Restaurant regarding a call, and recommended to explore an option to provide resources to a complainant regarding his interaction with Panama Joe's Restaurant.

After its **November 14, 2019** meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the **November 14, 2019** meeting are:

**COMMISSION**

- Sustained – 2 allegations
- Not Sustained – 2 allegations
- Exonerated - 3 allegations
- Unfounded – 28 allegations
- Other – 5 allegations
- Receive & File – 4 allegations

**CITY MANAGER**

- Sustained – 0 allegations
- Not Sustained – 2 allegations
- Exonerated – 10 allegations
- Unfounded – 32 allegations
- Other – 0 allegations
- Receive & File – 0 allegations

The Commission submitted a recommendation for the Long Beach Police Department to issue a department wide memo with information on the various types of pepper spray devices. Additionally, the commission recommended that translation services should be provided to citizens when needed, and officers should follow the policy on translation requests & services. The commission also had concern regarding a complainant's cellular phone and wanted an officer talked to regarding an incident.
