Reported October 2019 Regarding the August 2019 Meeting

All peace officer personnel records, including information relating to specific deliberations of the Citizen Police Complaint Commission and findings by the City Manager, shall be kept confidential to the extent required by law. In order to comply with this requirement, certain information may have been withheld in this report.

After its **August 8, 2019** meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the **August 8, 2019** meeting are:

**COMMISSION**

- Sustained – 8 allegations
- Not Sustained – 10 allegations
- Exonerated - 3 allegations
- Unfounded – 11 allegations

**CITY MANAGER**

Sustained– 0 allegations  
Not Sustained – 11 allegations  
Exonerated – 1 allegation  
Unfounded – 20 allegations

The Commission submitted a request for the Long Beach Police Department to look into how calls involving custody issues could be addressed when the minor opposes to go from one parent to the other. And, if there could be designated or alternate personnel within the department to handle custody transitions when these situations arise.
