All peace officer personnel records, including information relating to specific deliberations of the Citizen Police Complaint Commission and findings by the City Manager, shall be kept confidential to the extent required by law. In order to comply with this requirement, certain information may have been withheld in this report.

After its August 10, 2017 meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the August 10, 2017 meeting are:

COMMISSION

- Not sustained – 4 allegations
- Exonerated – 5 allegations
- Sustained – 1 allegation
- Other Training – 3 allegations
- Unfounded – 4 allegations

CITY MANAGER

Not sustained – 5 allegations
Exonerated – 5 allegations
Sustained – 0 allegation
Other Training – 2 allegations
Unfounded – 5 allegations

The Commission recommends the LBPD review, and if appropriate, update its policy and practice regarding officers and supervisors transporting people who are not arrested. The Commission requests a report in 90 days.
