This memorandum has been prepared in response to a request for the number of citations issued for fireworks. Due to the increased visitation to the City and calls for service, approximately four times the normal staffing levels are utilized to supplement Police Department (PD) services on the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday. Employees are required to work, unless they have scheduled/pre-approved vacation.

In collaboration, the Fire Department and PD seized **over 500 lbs.** of fireworks. In addition, the following citations were issued during the indicated timeframes.
