This letter serves as notification only in order to comply with federal filing requirements for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance (JAG) Program administered by the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). If awarded the grant, a formal request will be presented to the City Council to accept the grant and to make any applicable budget adjustments.

The City has participated in the JAG Program for over 11 years. The total grant amount is \$196,217 and will be used for a portion of the Los Angeles County Probation Officer (estimated \$36,217) and the continuation of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department DNA Senior Criminalist (estimated \$160,000).

The Police Department will file a grant application on behalf of the City of Long Beach. There is no City match requirement. The application deadline is June 30, 2016.

This memorandum meets the requirement stated in the grant solicitation document stating the application be made available for review by the governing body of the organization before the application is submitted to BJA.
