Subject: **Schedule for Fiscal Year 2023 Citywide Community Budget Meetings**

The City of Long Beach (City) is kicking off the Fiscal Year 2023 (FY 23) Budget development process, which prepares for the fiscal year starting October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023. This early launch fulfills last year’s request by the Mayor and City Council for earlier community engagement in the budget process and supports the City’s goals outlined in the Framework for Reconciliation.

In January 2022, the City will host four in-person citywide community meetings. At each community meeting, residents and community members will be given opportunities to share their priorities on City services and engage in conversation with the City Manager, Financial Management staff, and other City Department representatives. A general budget priority survey will also be made available online through Friday, January 28, 2022. The comments and feedback from these efforts will be synthesized and reported to the City Council in early Spring 2022, prior to the development of the Proposed FY 23 Budget.
