Subject: **Nominations for SCAG Regional Council District 30**

As described in a [memorandum](#) dated December 14, 2020, the City of Long Beach has the opportunity to fill a seat at the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG). Long Beach Councilmembers hold two seats on the SCAG Regional Council, and there is a vacancy for the SCAG Regional Council District 30 seat, represented exclusively by the City. The appointed representative will serve until the conclusion of the meeting of the SCAG General Assembly in 2022.

The December 14th memorandum outlined the process for being considered as the City's nominee for the SCAG Regional Council District 30 seat. Following a submission period, Councilwoman Cindy Allen was the only Councilmember to express interest in the vacancy and, thus, will be recommended to SCAG as the City's representative.
