Subject: **City Nominee for SCAG Regional Council District 30**

As described in a [memorandum](#) dated February 10, 2022, the City of Long Beach (City) has the opportunity to fill a seat at the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG). City Councilmembers hold two seats on the SCAG Regional Council, and the current term for the SCAG Regional Council District 30 seat, currently represented by Councilmember Cindy Allen, ends on May 4, 2022.

The February 10, 2022, memorandum outlined the process for Councilmembers to be considered as the City's nominee for the SCAG Regional Council District 30 seat. Following a submission period, Councilwoman Allen was the only Councilmember to express interest in the seat and, thus, will continue to serve as the City's representative until the conclusion of the meeting of the SCAG General Assembly in 2024.
