**Subject: Update on Senior Safe Home**

---

On February 14, 2023, the City Council requested the City Manager to work with all appropriate departments and report back within 90 days exploring the feasibility of providing a senior safe home for victims of elder abuse who are at greater risk of falling into homelessness in Long Beach and Los Angeles County, including providing a listing of any City-owned properties or land in which a senior safe home could be established, and any potential external funding sources.

Health Department staff are working with staff from Development Services to do the research on best-practices for this type of need, and if there are feasible options or City properties that may be able to serve this purpose, as well as the fiscal costs; however, additional time is needed to respond to this request.

It is anticipated that a response will be ready by October 27, 2023.
