Subject: **Groundbreaking Ceremony for New Fire Station 9 – August 27, 2024**

Mayor Rex Richardson, Fifth District Councilwoman Megan Kerr, Eighth District Councilmember Al Austin, and the City of Long Beach invite you and your staff to attend the groundbreaking ceremony for the new Fire Station 9 Project. The ceremony will be held on Tuesday, August 27, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. at 4101 Long Beach Blvd.

The new Fire Station 9 Project includes the demolition of the existing building onsite and the construction of a new 12,779 square foot, state of the art two-story LEED Silver designed fire station with rooftop solar. The site will be redeveloped with concrete paving, energy efficient site lighting, a trash enclosure, fencing, and gates. The project's landscaping is designed to follow the City's landscape design requirements for drought-tolerant plant selection and low flow irrigation systems. Additionally, a traffic signal at the Long Beach Boulevard and East Randolph Place intersection will be installed and the overhead power lines along Long Beach Blvd. will be moved underground at the station frontage.

Please note that this event is not open to the public, as the site is an active construction zone. The ceremony will be live streamed.
