Subject: **Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the El Dorado Duck Pond – Thursday, June 27, 2024**

Mayor Rex Richardson, Councilman Daryl Supernaw, and the Departments of Parks, Recreation and Marine and Public Works invite you and your staff to attend the El Dorado Duck Pond Ribbon Cutting Ceremony. The ceremony will be held on Thursday, June 27, 2024, at 12:00 p.m. at El Dorado Park West (2400 N. Studebaker Road).

The El Dorado Duck Pond project will improve public access, convert the pond into a recycled water reservoir, and upgrade the walkway surrounding the pond. The project will provide a new reclaimed water system to the adjacent golf course reducing the use of potable water. Visitors will experience improved water quality, enhanced habitat, and see enlarged wetlands and forebay areas.

The project is supported by Long Beach Measure A, Los Angeles County Measure W, grant funding from the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District Grant, in addition to federal grant funding in partnership with the Long Beach Water Department. The funding was approved by the Long Beach City Council on April 12, 2022.
