Subject: **City Nominee for SCAG Regional Council District 30**

As described in a [memorandum](#) dated March 7, 2024, the City of Long Beach (City) has the opportunity to fill a seat at the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG). City Councilmembers hold two seats on the SCAG Regional Council, and the current term for the SCAG Regional Council District 30 seat, represented by Vice Mayor Cindy Allen, ends in May 2024.

The memorandum outlined the process for Councilmembers to be considered as the City's nominee for the SCAG Regional Council District 30 seat. Following a submission period, Vice Mayor Allen was the only Councilmember to express interest in the seat; therefore, she will continue to serve as the City's representative until the conclusion of the meeting of the SCAG General Assembly in 2026.
