Councilwoman Kerr was proud to play a key role in ushering the long-awaited dedication of 48 acres of land known as Willow Springs Park as park space in perpetuity, and is committed to continuing to advocate for increased access to open and natural spaces within our city. She serves as Chair of the Mobility, Ports, & Infrastructure Committee, Vice Chair of the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee, and member of the Arts, Culture, & Tourism Committee. Born and raised in Bixby Knolls, Megan attended St. Anthony High School and Long Beach City College before receiving her Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from Cal Poly Pomona. She and her husband Andy, a North Long Beach native, have been married for 30 years and proudly raised three now-grown Long Beach natives of their own.
